ROADS ACT, 1993

TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PUBLIC ROADS

Pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, & Article 12 of the Roads Regulations 1994, notice is hereby given that Cork County Council proposes to temporarily close the following road for the period and reason specified below:

Road Subject of Proposed Closure
L-1015 Mountkeefe, Newmarket, Co Cork.

Period of Proposed Closure
From 09:00hrs on Monday 30th June 2025 to 18:00hrs on Friday 4th July 2025 (24hr Closure).

Reason for Proposed Closure
To facilitate the Construction of a Cattle Underpass.

Alternative Routes
Traffic travelling to Meelin on the R578 from Newmarket, at Mountkeefe Cross, continue straight on the R578 towards Freemount to Barleyhill Bridge. At Barleyhill bridge turn left onto the L-5029. Continue on the L-5029 to Meeneeshal Cross (T-Junction) At Meeneeshal Cross, turn right onto the L-1015 for Meelin Village.

Traffic travelling on the L-1015 to Mountkeefe Cross from Meelin shall divert right at Lehanes Cross, onto the L-1014. Continue on the L-1014 into Newmarket Town. At the funeral home, turn left onto the R578 to Mountkeefe Cross, or straight ahead onto the R578 to Newmarket Town.

Local Access will be maintained throughout the duration of the closure.

Objections to this proposed temporary road closure should be made in writing, to the undersigned, **quoting Ref: TRC-68-2025**, not later than 5.00pm on Tuesday, 17th June 2025. Telephone contact details should be included in the objection.

Cork County Council: I. Barbara Hassey, intend to apply for Planning Permission for: Retention of part-completed alterations to front elevation and alterations to front elevation of existing dwelling house. The proposed works will involve the alteration of the existing front porch, the construction of a new dormer window, the application of external insulation, alterations to existing site entrance, and all ancillary site works at 15 Suncourt, Middleton, Co. Cork. The planning application may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy at the offices of the Planning Authority during its public opening hours; A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made to the Authority in writing on payment of the prescribed fee within the period of 5 weeks beginning on the date of receipt by the Authority of the application.

Cork County Council: HRP Construction Limited are applying for planning permission for the construction of 74 no. housing units comprising a mix of 2, 3 and 4 bed units. The proposed scheme consists of 6 no. 4 bed semi-detached units, 44 no. 3 bed semi-detached/townhouse units and 22 no. 2 bed townhouses/bungalow units. Vehicular access is proposed to the north of the site onto the R619 road, pedestrian access is proposed to the east of the site off Lower Duhallow Park and a pedestrian crossing is also proposed at this location. Planning permission is also sought for the provision of 127 car parking spaces, drainage works, 44 no. covered bicycle parking, bin stores, landscaping, boundary treatments and all associated site development works at Quartertown Lower, Mallow, Co. Cork. A Natura Impact Statement will be submitted to the planning authority with this application. The Natura Impact Statement will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy during office hours at the office of the relevant Planning Authority. The Planning Application may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy at the offices of the Planning Authority during its public opening hours and a submission or observation in relation to the application may be made to the Authority in writing on payment of the prescribed fee within the period of 5 weeks beginning on the date of receipt by the Authority of the application.
